MASTER OF PASTORAL COUNSELING PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

Course requirements:

8 Units of Study

4 Units from any GTF online or distance course offerings

4 Units from the GTF or from transfer credit

Research Methodology is a required non-credit course for students who choose to complete the Master's Project

Project requirements:

The student must nominate a Project Consultant using the online form found on the GTF website. Questions regarding the selection of a Project Consultant should be directed to the Office of Academic Affairs (academicaffairs@gtfeducation.org).

The master's project in its final form must be 25,000-30,000 words (100-120 pages) in length, double-spaced, with 12 point Times New Roman (or comparable) font, and must have a table of contents as well as a bibliography if a minimum of 20 sources. It is also strongly recommended to have annotations for the 10-12 most important sources for the project.

When the project in its final form has been reviewed and approved by the student's Project Consultant, it must be submitted by the student to the GTF for final review. The master's project must be sent with the following forms by email attachment to the Office of the Registrar (registrar@gtfeducation.org).

Project Consultant's Report (form 114)

Non-Project Option requirements:

The Non-Project Option (NPO), which can be completed in lieu of the master's project, is available for students in this degree program. The NPO requires completion of two GTF E-Tutorial courses.

Program deadlines:

All academic and financial requirements must be met within three years of date of admission to the program.
