DOCTOR OF PSYCHOLOGY in PASTORAL LOGOTHERAPY PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

Academic requirements:

10 Units of Study

5 Units earned by completion of the online Pastoral Logotherapy Core Curriculum

5 Units earned by completion of E-Tutorials in *Pastoral Care and Counseling Psychology*

Attendance at a five-day residential Practicum in Pastoral Logotherapy

Practicum in Pastoral Logotherapy:

The five-day residential Practicum is praxis-oriented, focusing on the practice of logotherapy in a counseling situation. Prior to attendance, each student will have read any pre-set text(s) required by the faculty person moderating the Logotherapy Practicum. Beyond that, the student brings to the Practicum a verbatim narrative (prepared in APA case study format) of five specific counseling cases in which he/she has been involved. These case studies are used as the basis for discussion and skills assessment in the Practicum under the leadership of a qualified logotherapist who holds both the Diplomate in Logotherapy and a doctorate in a cognate field of counseling psychology.

Depending on the situation and opportunity, the Practicum may either be a one-on-one tutorial encounter between student and faculty or a small group of students in a seminar environment moderated by the faculty. Completion of the Practicum is the final academic requirement of this degree program.

Program deadlines:

All academic and financial requirements must be met within three years of date of admission to the program.
